For electors and polling supervisors to fulfill their civic duties more quickly and simply ONPE is in full organization of the 2nd Presidential Election

The National Office of Electoral Processes of Peru (ONPE) is in full organization of the June 5th Second Presidential Election for electors and polling supervisors to be able to fulfill their civic duties more fluently and simply, the electoral organization's Chief Mariano Cucho Espinoza informed today.

Only two candidates will appear in the ballot paper to be provided to electors, reason why he requested them to get information on proposals submitted by both candidates for the Presidency of the Republic and thus going to polls with a conscious vote.

Likewise, he urged over 22,901,054 electors to go to vote early, even more when polling stations are located a short distance from their residences.

In case of polling supervisors, they will must fulfill an easier task, since it is only one election and no three as at the April 10th elections, he expressed.

The work will also be quickly in the counting stage, since there will be two candidates. Blank votes and invalid ballots will only be added to the said stage.

According to the Article 64 of Organic Law on Elections, polling supervisors, elected for the first round, will must continue exercising this civic duty on Sunday Jun 5th, 2016, Cucho Espinoza recalled. He requested them to attend at 7:00 A.M. for voting to start at 8:00 A.M., which will allow the electoral process to be fluent.

ONPE will hold a new training day on May 29th, 2016. The said training day will be addressed to 463,842 polling supervisors, who will be able to strengthen the characteristic tasks of installation, voting and counting.

Over 22 million domestic and foreign electors will be able to have access to several technological and information platforms, which have been established, through their computers, laptops, smartphone and other mobile devices, ONPE Chief informed.





On www.onpe.gob.pe web site, electors will be able to learn on voting systems to be implemented on June 5th, 2016, the directory of ONPE's offices at national level, electoral fines, recommendations and prohibitions during the process.

The application titled "Demo Voto Electronico" is already available. The said application will allow electors to practice the electronic voting as many times as they wish. This simulator is available on the web site and on smart devices such as smartphones and tablets, via download from Google Play virtual store.

For ease of electoral actors, ONPE launched "Local de votación" and "Info Elecciones" applications, which include information on elections, available on Google Play for mobile devices with Android operating system.

Electors will also be able to know their polling stations by simply sending Peruvian Identity Card (ID)'s number in a text message (SMS) to 6673 starting the next week, thanks to covenants ratified with Movistar, Claro, Entel and Bitel Peru phone enterprises.

Electronic voting

In-person electronic voting will continue being implemented in 19 districts of Lima Metropolitan Area and Callao, where the April 10th electoral day was held due to a decision agreed with the National Elections Board (JNE) and two political parties to participate at this Second Presidential Election, ONPE Chief announced.

The said districts include Chaclacayo, Lince, Lurin, Magdalena del Mar, Pachacamac, Pueblo Libre, Pucusana, Punta Hermosa, Punta Negra, San Bartolo, San Isidro, Barranco, Santa Maria del Mar, Surquillo, San Luis and Cieneguilla, all of them located in Lima, as well as La Punta and Mi Peru (Callao) and Pacaran (Cañete).

743,169 electors, who will electronically cast the right to vote, account for 3% of electorate, whe-
